Plunder New Lands with Pablo

I am Pablo Sánchez: I live in Madrid and this is my Pirates of Barracuda Bay creation.

My love for LEGO® bricks was passed down to me as a child from my father.

After the Spanish Civil War, my dad worked as a craftsman, making dolls. When I came along, he saw LEGO bricks as a chance to give me something he had never had, a chance to make toys and create a world of play that was just for me. We would play pirates together and that's where his nickname for me, "Little Pirate" came from.

It's been almost thirty years since the Classic Pirates were released, so I decided I had to help bring them back.

This set was for my dad, for myself and for all the other boys and girls who grew up playing pirates.

I started where the story left off in 1989, with Captain Redbeard and his crew, stranded mid-adventure.


That's when I remembered the sequence from a classic pirate film, where the crew happen upon an island made from shipwrecks. I started to experiment with that idea, scaling the concept down and adding in details such as plants, animals, hidden traps and spaces, and bountiful treasures.

The project took me one very sleepless week to design and another to create it digitally.

In the end, it was made up of around 2650 individual pieces. After I had submitted the work to the LEGO® Ideas platform, I was overwhelmed by the avalanche of support I received. Within 25 days, I hit the big 10,000.

My hope for this set is that it helps to create a new generation of "little pirates."

I hope it starts a new era of boys and girls who get as much joy from the adventures of Redbeard as I did.



Pillage de nouvelles terres avec Pablo

Je m'appelle Pablo Sánchez, je vis à Madrid, et voici ma création : les pirates de la baie de Barracuda.

Ma passion pour les briques LEGO® m'a été transmise par mon père lorsque j'étais enfant.

Après la guerre civile espagnole, mon père a travaillé comme artisan. Il fabriquait des poupées. Lorsque je suis né, il a voulu qu'il n'avait jamais eu, soit la chance de créer des jouets et un univers de jeu juste pour moi. Nous avons joué aux pirates ensemble, et c'est à cette époque qu'il s'est mis à me surnommer « petit pirate ».

Cela fait presque trente ans que les Pirates classiques ont été créés, alors j'ai décidé de contribuer à leur retour.

Cet ensemble a été conçu pour mon père, pour moi et pour tous les autres enfants qui ont grandi en jouant aux pirates.

J'ai commencé là où l'histoire s'est terminée : en 1989, avec le capitaine Barbe Rouge et son équipage, dont l'aventure a pris fin après que leur navire s'est échoué.

Je me suis alors souvenu de la scène d'un film de pirates classique, où l'équipage se retrouvait sur une île composée d'épaves de navires. J'ai commencé à essayer différentes choses en me basant sur cette idée et en imaginant le concept à plus petite échelle avec l'ajout de détails, comme des plantes, des animaux, des pièges et des lieux cachés, ainsi que de grands trésors.

Cela m'a pris une bonne semaine sans sommeil pour concevoir le projet, puis une autre pour sa création numérique.

Au final, il était composé d'environ 2 650 pièces individuelles. Après avoir soumis le travail sur la plateforme LEGO® Ideas, j'ai été très touché par l'avalanche de soutien que j'ai reçu. En 25 jours, j'ai atteint les 10 000 votes.

Saquea nuevas tierras con Pablo

Me llamo Pablo Sánchez: vivo en Madrid y esta es mi creación: Piratas de Bahía Barracuda.

Heredé el amor por los bricks LEGO® de mi padre, cuando era niño.

Luego de la guerra civil española, mi padre trabajó como artesano, confeccionando muñecas. Cuando llegué yo, vió en los bricks LEGO la oportunidad de ofrecerme algo que él nunca había tenido: la posibilidad de crear juguetes e inventar un mundo de juego solo para mí. Jugábamos juntos a los piratas y de ahí surgió el apodo que me puso: Pequeño Pirata.

Han pasado casi treinta años desde que se puso a la venta la línea Classic Pirates, así que decidí que tenía el deber de traerlos de regreso.

Este set es para mi padre, para mí y para todos los niños y niñas que crecieron jugando a los piratas.

Empecé por donde se quedó la historia en 1989, con el capitán Redbeard y su tripulación varados en medio de una aventura.

Fue entonces cuando recordé una secuencia de un clásico del cine de piratas en la que la tripulación llega hasta una isla hecha de restos de barcos naufragados. Empecé a experimentar con esa idea, concentrándola y añadiendo detalles como plantas, animales, trampas ocultas, espacios y abundantes tesoros.



El proyecto me exigió una semana sin dormir para diseñarlo y otra para crearlo digitalmente.

Al final, se componía de unas 2650 piezas individuales. Cuando compartí mi trabajo en la plataforma LEGO® Ideas, la avalancha de apoyos que recibí fue abrumadora. Llegué al gran 10.000 en solo 25 días.

Lo que espero de este set es que sirva para crear una nueva generación de pequeños piratas.

Ojalá inicie una nueva era de niños y niñas que disfruten de las aventuras de Redbeard tanto como yo.

Meet Matey Milan

My name is Milan Madge. I'm originally from the UK and I'm a Model Designer at the LEGO Group in Denmark.

It was amazing to help bring Pablo's vision to life and to help add that little bit of LEGO® magic – especially because it was so clear from his storytelling that the theme meant a lot to him.

It wasn't all smooth sailing. Parts such as raised baseplates, boat hulls, masts, palm trees and monkeys were out of production, some since the 1990s!

Released in 1989, the original sets kickstarted a new way of playing and storytelling within the LEGO Group, but, the beloved Captain Redbeard and his crew had been missing ever since we knew him as kids.

We wanted to tell the next chapter of his story and get these characters back in the hands of those same kids, 30 years later. Our aim was to keep the great stories Pablo had created, the jail cell, the inn, the farm, the Captain's cabin, but replace the structures with the remains of Captain Redbeard's ship. The characters would resemble the crew that left us in the 1990s, albeit with a little gray in their beards.

Deciding that the model should be able to change back into a seaworthy vessel posed a real challenge, but it had to be done. After all, what are pirates without a ship?

I remember how happy Pablo was when we first showed him the concept, and I can imagine how happy others will be when they see Captain Redbeard and the Black Seas Barracuda coming to life again.

Rencontre avec le matelot Milan

Je m'appelle Milan Madge. Je suis originaire du Royaume-Uni et je suis concepteur de modèles pour le Groupe LEGO au Danemark.

C'était très touchant d'aider Pablo à concrétiser sa vision et d'y ajouter un peu de magie LEGO®, car son histoire dévoilait clairement à quel point ce thème était important pour lui.

Malheureusement, nous n'avons pas toujours eu le vent dans les voiles. Des pièces du projet, comme les plaques de base surélevées, les coques de bateau, les mâts, les palmiers et les singes, avaient été retirées de la production, et certaines, depuis les années 1990 !

Lancés en 1989, les ensembles originaux ont donné le coup d'envoi à une nouvelle façon de jouer et de raconter des histoires au sein du Groupe LEGO. Par contre, le bien-aimé capitaine Barbe Rouge et son équipage avaient disparu depuis que nous les avions connus lorsque nous étions enfants.

Nous voulions raconter le prochain chapitre de leur histoire et remettre ces personnages entre les mains de ces mêmes enfants, 30 ans plus tard. Notre objectif consistait à garder les excellentes histoires que Pablo avait inventées, la cellule de prison, l'auberge, la ferme et la cabine du capitaine, mais à remplacer les structures par les restes du navire du capitaine Barbe Rouge. Les personnages devaient ressembler aux membres de l'équipage qui nous avaient quittés dans les années 1990, mais avec un peu de gris dans leurs barbes.

Nous avons décidé que le modèle devait pouvoir se transformer en navire navigable, et cela a posé un défi de taille que nous voulions absolument relever. Après tout, que sont les pirates sans leur navire ?

Je me souviens à quel point Pablo était heureux lorsque nous lui avons montré le concept, et je ne peux qu'imaginer le bonheur d'autres personnes quand elles verront le capitaine Barbe Rouge et le Requin noir reprendre vie.

Conoce al grumete Milan

Me llamo Milan Madge. soy originario del Reino Unido y trabajo en Dinamarca como diseñador de modelos para The LEGO Group.

Fue fantástico hacer realidad la visión de Pablo y aportar esa pequeña dosis de magia al estilo LEGO® (en especial porque su historia ponía claramente de manifiesto que el tema significaba mucho para él).

El viento no siempre sopló a nuestro favor. Había piezas, como las placas elevadas, los cascos, los mástiles, las palmeras y los changos, que ya no se fabricaban; algunas de ellas desde los años 90!

Lanzados en 1989, los sets originales dieron comienzo a una nueva forma de jugar y contar historias dentro de The LEGO Group, pero el querido capitán Redbeard y su tripulación no habían vuelto a aparecer desde que los conocimos cuando éramos niños.

Queríamos contar el siguiente capítulo de la historia y volver a poner los personajes en manos de los mismos niños, 30 años después. Nuestro objetivo era conservar las grandes historias que Pablo había creado (la cárcel, la taberna, la granja, el camarote del capitán, etc.), sustituyendo las estructuras por los restos del barco del capitán Redbeard. Los personajes se parecerían a la tripulación que nos dejó en los años 90, aunque con las barbas más grises.

La decisión de que el modelo pudiera volver a transformarse en un buque en condiciones de navegar planteaba un verdadero desafío, pero había que hacerlo. Después de todo, ¿qué son los piratas sin un barco?

Recuerdo lo feliz que estaba Pablo cuando le enseñamos nuestra propuesta por primera vez, y me imagino lo contentos que se pondrán los demás cuando descubran que el capitán Redbeard y el Black Seas Barracuda han vuelto a la vida.

I'm Austin William Carlson. I'm originally from Pennsylvania, USA and I am a Minifigure Designer for the LEGO Group.

When I heard about Pirates of Barracuda Bay becoming a possible LEGO® Ideas set, there was no way I was going to miss out on working on such an inspired classic model - Pirate Bay was my JAM as a child! After all, Captain Redbeard and I were both released in 1989, although his beard was better than mine.

Having the chance to tell a new story with the characters that I grew up with really was a dream come true.

From the submission to the final development, there were lots of designers whose eyes lit up from working on this project. It reignited a magical world here and I really believe it will do the same for LEGO fans everywhere.

Capitán Redbeard



Former gunner of the Cross-Bone Clipper ship. The definition of a loose cannon.

Port

One of the Broadside Brothers. Joined the crew at Rock Island Refuge. Magnificent moustache, marooned regularly.

Starboard

The other Broadside Brother. Shared his love of face furniture with his brother but lets himself down with his cooking.

Tattooga

Master craftsman with extraordinary strength. Rumor has it, he once beat a shark in an arm-wrestling contest.

Jack "Dark Shark" Doubloons

The bosun of the ship, Jack Doubloons made sure everything was rigged out and above board.

Membres de l'équipage

Lady Anchor

Lady Anne Anchor était une brave aventurière. Elle maintenait les membres de l'équipage à distance et veillait à ce que tout se déroule bien sur le navire quand Barbe Rouge était en mer.

Timonier Riggings

Proche confident du capitaine, Riggings était le seul autre membre de l'équipage auquel l'emplacement du trésor avait été confié. Sa vision reflétait toujours celle du capitaine, tel un miroir (car ils portent leur cache-œil sur des côtés opposés...).

Robin Loot

Ancienne artilleuse du navire Cross-Bone Clipper. Elle est dangereuse et imprévisible.

Port

L'un des frères Broadside. Il s'est joint à l'équipage au Nid des pirates. Il possède une magnifique moustache et fait naufrage régulièrement.

Starboard

L'autre frère Broadside. Tout comme son frère, il possède également une moustache. Mais il est plus doué pour entretenir sa moustache que pour cuisiner.

Tattooga

Maître artisan doté d'une force extraordinaire. La rumeur dit qu'il a déjà battu un requin lors d'un bras de fer.

Jack « requin noir » Doubloons

Maître d'équipage du navire, Jack Doubloons s'assurait que tout était gréé et sous contrôle.

Los tripulantes

Lady Anchor

Lady Anne Anchor fue una magnífica espadachina. Mantenía a la tripulación a raya, se ocupaba de que todo estuviera bajo control y se aseguraba de que el barco estuviera en perfectas condiciones cuando Redbeard se hacia a la mar.

Contramaestre Riggings

Hombre de confianza para el capitán, Riggings era el único miembro de la tripulación, además de él, que conocía la ubicación del tesoro; siempre miraba directamente al ojo al capitán (ya que ambos tenían los parches en lados opuestos).

Robin Loot

Antigua artillera del Cross-Bone Clipper. La viva imagen de un gatillo fácil.

Port

Uno de los hermanos Broadside. Se unió a la tripulación en Rock Island Refuge. Tenía un espléndido bigote y visitaba con frecuencia las islas desiertas.

Starboard

El otro hermano Broadside. Compartía con su hermano el amor por el vello facial, pero su manera de cocinar era decepcionante.

Tattooga

Un maestro artesano de fuerza extraordinaria. Se rumora que una vez venció a un tiburón jugando a las vencidas.

Jack "Dark Shark" Doubloons

Jack Doubloons, primer oficial del barco, se aseguraba de que todo estuviera bien organizado y en regla.
